#### **Edward Byrne Memorial FY 2021 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program – Local Solicitation Projected Use of Funds**

The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program is the primary provider of Federal criminal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions. JAG funds support all components of the criminal justice system, from multi-jurisdictional drug and gang task forces to crime prevention and domestic violence programs, courts, corrections, treatment and justice information sharing initiatives. On or before August 9, 2021, the City of Baytown will submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$23,683.00. If awarded, the funds will be available for use until September 30, 2022. The public is allowed to review and comment on the JAG Program proposed use of funds. This notice is provided to inform the public of the availability of the Program Year 2021 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program:
