These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the **City of Baytown**.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS:

On or about **October 6, 2021** the **City of Baytown**, will submit a request to the General Land Office (GLO) for the release of Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery funds under the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2018, and Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act, 2017 (Public Law 115-56) to undertake a project known as **Baytown - 20-065-113-C310 - street and drainage** for the purpose of **the purpose of the project is to conduct drainage infrastructure improvements to facilitate proper stormwater conveyance and reduce the impact of future flooding.**

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

Flood and Drainage Facilities Subrecipient shall replace storm sewer culverts, regrade roadside ditches, rehab outfall ditches with associated pavement repair, and complete associated appurtenances. No acquisition is required.

LOCATION:

All work will occur in the City of Baytown, Chambers County, Texas in the following locations:

LINCOLN CEDARS

- Lincoln Cedars Drive from State Hwy 146 to Approx. 100 LF East of Carver Street (29.774725, -94.912084)
- Booker Street/Carver Street from Lincoln Cedars Drive (West) to Lincoln Cedars Drive (East) (29.77606, -94.911582)

JULIE ANN VILLA

- Site 1 Outfall (Southwest) from Southwest corner of Circle Dr. approx. 300 LF Southwest to Drainage Ditch (29.810463 -94.905366)
- Site 2 South and East Circle Drive from West end of West Circle Drive to approx. 250 LF Northeast on East Circle Drive (29.810599 -94.904334)

- Site 3 Outfall (East) from End of Site 2 to approx. 190 LF East to Drainage Ditch (29.81122, -94.90369)
- Site 4 Drainage Ditch (East of East Circle Drive) from End of Site 3 to 500 LF South to main outfall ditch (29.810520, -94.904334)

PROJECT ISSUES: Coastal Zone Management, Endangered Species, Floodplains, Wetlands and Soil Suitability/ Slope/ Erosion/ Drainage/ Storm Water Runoff and Historic Preservation: A full, detailed list of mitigation measures can be found in the Environmental Review Record.

PROJECT SIZE: Approximately 5.0 acres.

TOTAL GRANT AMOUNT: Project will cost \$1,785,864.00 and will be paid for with \$1,785,864.00 in HUD CDBG-DR grant funds administered by the General Land Office.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The **City of Baytown** has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the **City of Baytown, 2401 Market Street, Baytown, Texas** and may be examined or copied weekdays 9:00 A.M to 4:00 P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the **City of Baytown, 2401 Market Street, Baytown, Texas 77520**. All comments received by **October 5, 2021** or within eighteen (18) days following this posting (whichever is later) will be considered by the **City of Baytown** prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The **City of Baytown** certifies to GLO that **Rick Davis**, in their capacity as **City Manager** consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. GLO's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the **City of Baytown** to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

GLO will accept objections to its release of funds and the **City of Baytown's** certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the **City of Baytown**; (b) the **City of Baytown** has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by GLO; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to the Community Development and Revitalization Program, General Land Office at Texas Disaster Recovery Program 1700 N. Congress, Austin, TX 78701. Potential objectors should contact GLO to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
