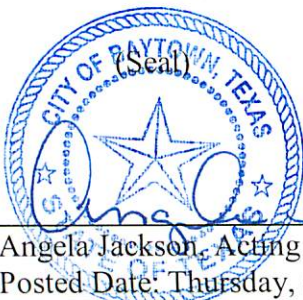
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Baytown will hold public hearings on **Thursday, October 14, 2021** in the **Council Chamber at Baytown City Hall, 2401 Market Street, Baytown, TX**, at **6:30 P.M.**, giving all interested parties the right to appear and be heard on the following items:

- (1) The proposed rezoning of approximately 20.82 acres, generally located east of Thompson Road and north of Ellis School Road, legally described as PT TRS 14 14B 15B & 16B BLK 12 Highland Farms, Harris County Texas, from an Open Space/Recreation (OR) to a General Commercial (GC) Zoning District.
- (2) The proposed rezoning of approximately 34.07 acres, generally located east of Sjolander Road and south of E IH 10, legally described as TRS 9C & 31, Abstract 4 W Bloodgood, Harris County, Texas, from an Open Space/Recreation (OR) to a Light Industrial (LI) Zoning District.
- (3) A Special Use Permit for approximately 5.77 acres, generally located south of Needlepoint Road and approximately 6,000 feet east of Sjolander Road, legally described as a portion of Tract II, Abstract 4 W Bloodgood, Harris County, Texas, for a proposed railyard.
